Protest Procedure:

1. All questions relating to qualifications of competitors, to interpretation of the rules, to suspensions and to disputes or protest shall be deferred to the Tournament State Cup Committee and Staff whose decision shall be final and binding.
2. To be valid/ eligible for consideration, protests relating to the grounds, goal post, bars and their apparatus of the game should be in writing and submitted to the referee and opposing coach prior to the start of the game.
3. To be valid and eligible for consideration, protests shall be lodged with the Referee and the opposing coach at the game site within fifteen (15) minutes after the end of the game.
4. To be valid and eligible for consideration, the protest regarding a game must be filed with the Tournament State Cup Committee within two (2) hours after the completion of the game in question.
5. All protests and appeals must have the official P & A Form completed. All protest and appeals must include the following:
 - a) A fee of \$300.00 in cash/certified check (If you win your protest the fee will returned minus 50.00 admin fee)
 - b) Five (5) copies of the protest form
 - c) Five (5) copies of all information to be presented by witnesses.
6. To be valid and eligible for consideration, the coach of the opposing team has the ability to write down his point of facts without seeing the other coaches written statement.
7. The coach of the opposing team has up to three (3) hours to file their points of fact or other relevant information and submit it to headquarters.
8. The Chairman of the State Cup Committee shall notify all teams or player of the committee's findings and possible hearing date and times. Notification shall be via the team representative if the coach or player cannot be contacted.
9. All protest hearings will be held within 24 hours of the filing of the protest at State Cup Headquarters. If the protest occurs on the last day of the tournament, the AYSA Executive Director receive the appeal within seven (7) days of the end of the Tournament. The State Cup committee will be convened via telephone conference call.
10. The AYSA Executive Director will notify both coaches of the P & A decision after hearing.
11. The decision of the State Cup committee is final.
12. A protest may not be filed against the P & A decision.
