Re: AYSA Travel Update

AYSA Members and Affiliates,

Alaska Youth Soccer highest priority continues to remain committed to provide a safe playing environment for our athletes, coaches, referees, families, and communities. The implementation of appropriate safety protocols as outlined in AYSA's COVID-19 Return-To-Play guidelines are to assist clubs and leagues as they work to ensure compliance with the required health and safety standards that have been put in place to mitigate the risk of spreading COVID-19. This updated notice is to ensure that individuals from within your organization traveling to Alaska from the lower 48 follow the appropriate advisories and health mandates outlined by the State of Alaska.

### What Happens if A Coach, Player or Team Travels Out of State?

The individual (s) will need to notify the club that they will be or have traveled out of state. On return the individual (s) will follow the state travel [Mandate 010 Revised](#). They are asked to self-quarantine until they receive a negative test result. They are to "minimize interactions" until they receive a negative result, which means no club activity. The individual (s) would need a negative result (**or 14 days self-quarantine have passed since arrival**) before resuming regular club activity; a second test is not required.

- a. A copy of the Covid-19 Health Screening Result must be sent to the registered Club point of contact and the Alaska Youth Soccer State Office prior to the individual(s) approval for return to club activity.

Alaskans **who travel outside the state for trips less than 72 hours**- No test or quarantine is required. Traveler will self- monitor for 14 days after arrival for any symptoms, even mild ones.

Continued communication with Club point of contact regarding symptoms during process of return to club activity.
