Overtime Periods. (For semifinal/ championship games) tied at the end of regulation play, two complete overtime periods will be played.

If a game is still tied at the end of the prescribed overtime play, FIFA "Kicks from the Penalty Mark" rules will apply to determine the winner using the 9 or 11 players on the field at the conclusion of the second overtime and following the FIFA Laws of the Game.
