The Alaska State Cup is open to Alaska Competitive Teams 11-U through 19-U, teams must be Alaskan based and Alaska residents to be eligible to participate; players, coaches and teams must be currently registered under the (AYSA) umbrella in the 2020-2021 seasonal year with a valid team roster with (AYSA) player cards. Teams and players must have participated in an (AYSA) respective Sanctioned Summer League and are currently in good standing with Alaska Youth Soccer, to be eligible for participation. All players must be properly registered under the (AYSA) umbrella and living in Alaska prior to the July State Cup Application Deadline. The Player Eligibility Placement Deadline (6/18/21); players are to be properly registered as a member of (AYSA) by this date.

Adults over the age of 18 listed on the team roster who may have the opportunity to have direct interaction or unmonitored access with amateur athletes as a representative of Alaska Youth Soccer Association and all covered Alaska Youth Soccer Association Member Organizations such as clubs, leagues and associations are required to an annual cleared Background Check, review the (AYSA) Code of Conduct, and SafeSport certification.

**The team will be participating in the Alaska State Cup competition have meet or have provided:**

- a) Rosters of participating players have been checked and birth dates for each player has been verified.
- b) All players are entered in the State Roster System and are properly Registered in the Club in accordance with the rules of US Youth Soccer (Policy on Players and Playing Rules, 201 and 209) and with the Alaska Youth Soccer.
- c) No player is restricted from playing due to a concussion received in League or State play.

It is understood that the Club will be held responsible for any false information\*.

## Reference- Alaska State Cup; Format and Rules

6.2 **Teams and Players:** Prior to participation in the Alaska State Cup, each team and its players shall:

6.2.1 Be properly registered with AYSA and rostered with AYSA in accordance with the rules of US Youth Soccer (Policy on Players and Playing Rules, 201 and 209) and the AYSA.

6.2.1.1 Valid team roster and current seasonal year US Youth Soccer player and coach member passes.

6.2.1.2 Players may only play for one team entered in a State Cup (any state/region) during a seasonal year.

6.2.1.3 Players must be currently living in Alaska and registered for play as a member of AYSA.

6.2.1.4 Players are to be properly registered and/or transferred to the team; no guest players allowed.

6.2.2 **Player Eligibility Placement Deadline (6/18/21):** player MUST be properly registered as a member of (AYSA) by this date.

6.2.2.1 No out of state players may be rostered to AYSA teams. (Split custody in between different states situations must be discussed with the State Office prior to the eligibility placement deadline).

6.2.3 **Good Standing:** Teams and players are in good standing with AYSA, their respective leagues, are in compliance with, and has not violated, any of the bylaws and policies of US Youth Soccer and the AYSA.

6.4.1 Any coach, manager, representative, member, or official found guilty of knowingly using an ineligible player or violating the unethical conduct of the Code of Conduct policy is not eligible to compete further in the National Championships competitions in the current and subsequent seasonal year.

6.4.2 A player found guilty of submitting falsified birth information is prohibited from competing further in National Championships competitions in the current and subsequent seasonal year.

6.4.3 Age Verification: At any point prior to or during the competition, the AYSA may request a team to verify a player's age. Teams will provide proof-of-age documents to the AYSA office.

6.4.4 At any point using ineligible player(s) or ineligible player (s) listed on roster regardless of if the player did not participate in a game, all games are to be considered a forfeit and fines applied accordingly.
