The Alaska State Cup is open to Alaska Competitive Teams 11-U through 19-U, teams must be Alaskan based and Alaska residents to be eligible to participate. Players, coaches and teams must be currently registered under the Alaska Youth Soccer Association (AYSA) umbrella in the 2021-2022 seasonal year with a valid team roster with AYSA player cards. Teams and players must have participated in an AYSA-sanctioned summer league and be in good standing with Alaska Youth Soccer to be eligible for participation. All players must be properly registered under the AYSA umbrella and living in Alaska prior to the July State Cup application deadline. Players are to be properly registered as a member of AYSA by the player eligibility placement deadline (6/18/22).

Adults over the age of 18 listed on the team roster who may have the opportunity to have direct interaction or unmonitored access with amateur athletes as a representative of AYSA and all covered AYSA member organizations such as clubs, leagues, and associations are required to undergo an annual background check, review the AYSA Code of Conduct, and undergo SafeSport certification.

Teams that will be participating in the Alaska State Cup competition must have met the following criteria:

- a) Rosters of participating players must have been checked and birth dates for each player must have been verified.
- b) All players must be entered in the state roster system and be properly registered in the club in accordance with the rules of US Youth Soccer (Policy on Players and Playing Rules, 201 and 209) and with the Alaska Youth Soccer.

No player is restricted from playing due to a concussion received in league or state play.

It is understood that the club will be held responsible for any false information. Clubs found to have given false or misleading information may be fined, suspended, sanctioned or any combination of these.

Reference- Alaska State Cup Format and Rules

6.2 **Teams and Players:** Prior to participation in the Alaska State Cup, each team and its players shall:

6.2.1 Be properly registered with AYSA and rostered with AYSA in accordance with the rules of US Youth Soccer (Policy on Players and Playing Rules, 201 and 209) and AYSA, and have met the following criteria:

6.2.1.1 Have obtained a valid team roster and current seasonal year US Youth Soccer player and coach member passes.

6.2.1.2 Players may only play for one team entered in a State Cup (any state/region) during a seasonal year.

6.2.1.3 Players must be currently living in Alaska and registered for play as a member of AYSA.

6.2.1.4 Players are to be properly registered and/or transferred to the team - no guest players are allowed.

6.2.2 **Player Eligibility Placement Deadline (6/18/22):** players MUST be properly registered as a member of (AYSA) by this date.

6.2.2.1 No out of state players may be rostered to AYSA teams. Situations involving split custody between different states must be discussed with the state office prior to the eligibility placement deadline.

6.2.3 **Good Standing:** Teams and players must be in good standing with AYSA and its respective leagues, and have not violated any of the bylaws and policies of US Youth Soccer and AYSA.

6.4.1 Any coach, manager, representative, member, or official found guilty of knowingly using an ineligible player or violating the Code of Conduct Policy is not eligible to compete further in the National Championships competitions in the current and subsequent seasonal year.

6.4.2 A player found guilty of submitting falsified birth information is prohibited from competing further in National Championships competitions in the current and subsequent seasonal year.

6.4.3 **Age Verification:** At any point prior to or during the competition, AYSA may request that a team verify a player's age. Teams will provide proof-of-age documents to the AYSA office.

6.4.4 If a team/club is found to have at any point used ineligible player(s) or had ineligible player(s) listed on roster, regardless of if the player participated in a game, all games are to be considered a forfeit and fines will be applied accordingly.
