ALASKA YOUTH SOCCER State Cup Placement Affiliate Team Eligibility Form

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The Affiliate Team Eligibility Form for an affiliate Alaska team to receive permission to register and attend the Alaska State Cup must be completed and submitted prior to the registration deadline. The form is not valid until stamped and approved by the Alaska State Association Office. Submittal of the completed form and *Team Tournament Roster* will be processed through the Alaska State Association Office.

Alaska Geographic Constraints: Affiliate Teams who have geographic constraints will be eligible to qualify for participation during the current seasonal year by registering and competing in an Alaska Approved Sanctioned qualifying state league. The team must demonstrate continuity of rosters between the state league during the current seasonal year and National Championships competitions (Alaska State Cup) by maintaining a minimum of six (6) players that are common to the rosters of all competitions.

AYSA INSTRUCTIONS AND QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES BELOW:

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- The form must be completed fully and typed or printed neatly.
- Email the completed Affiliate Team Eligibility Form and Official Team Roster to the AYSA State Office. Email to alaskayouthsoccer@gmail.com

Affiliate Team Eligibility: The Alaska State Cup is open to qualified affiliated Alaska competitive teams. The competitions provided under the US National Championships Policy for the following age groups: 11U through 19U.

Teams and Players: Prior to participation in the Alaska State Cup, each team and its players shall:

- Be properly registered with AYSA and rostered with AYSA in accordance with the rules of US Youth Soccer (Policy on Players and Playing Rules, 201 and 209) and the AYSA.
- Valid team roster and current seasonal year US Youth Soccer player and coach member passes.
- Players may only play for one team entered in a State Cup (any state/region) during a seasonal year.
- Players must be currently living in Alaska and registered for play as a member of AYSA.
- Players are to be properly registered and/or transferred to the team; no guest players allowed.
- Teams and players are in good standing with AYSA, their respective leagues, are in compliance with, and has not violated, any of the bylaws and policies of US Youth Soccer and the AYSA.

Sanctioned League: Teams must be registered and compete in a four-team Alaska Approved Sanctioned league during the current summer seasonal year to be eligible to compete in the State Cup Tournament.

- The team must demonstrate continuity of rosters between the league during the current seasonal year and National Championships competitions by maintaining a minimum of nine (9) players that are common to the rosters of all competitions.

Geographic Constraints: Teams who have **geographic constraints** will be eligible to qualify for participation during the current seasonal year by registering and competing in an Alaska Approved Sanctioned qualifying state league.

- The team must **demonstrate continuity of rosters** between the state league during the current seasonal year and National Championships competitions by maintaining a minimum of six (6) players that are common to the rosters of all competitions.

Exceptions: Any exceptions to this must be granted by the Alaska State Cup Committee.
