POLICY TOPIC: Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug Policy POLICY NO: AYSA102004

Policy: It is the policy of the Alaska Youth Soccer Association (AYSA) that no alcohol be sold or brought to AYSA sanctioned youth soccer games. It is the responsibility of the affiliated clubs and organizers of Alaska Youth soccer events to ensure that this policy is strictly adhered to. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in suspension of sanctioned events and/or placing the affiliate in "bad standing" with the Association.

Adults may not smoke in the presence or near any youth player, this includes vehicles, rooms, and practice or play fields. All smokers are ask to leave the area, assuring the players are properly supervised by another adult, before leaving to smoke.

All illegal drug use is strictly prohibited.
