## Field Marshal Guidelines For Alaska Youth Soccer Events

## EACH TEAM SHOULD PROVIDE A FIELD MARSHAL PER GAME

FIELD MARSHALS MUST WEAR THE FIELD MARSHAL IDENTIFICATION AND HAVE A CELL PHONE AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES.

## **Field Marshal Duties:**

- 1. Field Marshals ensure that players/coaches are on their side of the field and that spectators are on their side.
- 2. Field Marshals should inform the spectators that they must stay behind the spectator lines so that referees. have free run down the field.
- 3. Field Marshals should inform the spectators that no one should stand behind the goal area during the game.
- 4. No dogs or other animals are allowed at the fields, headquarters, award area/vendors/scoreboards (exception: service animals).
- 5. No mechanical devices may be used to cheer; approved songs, chants, cheers, and clappers etc.
- 6. No alcoholic beverages, glass containers, tobacco, or controlled substances are allowed on the fields.
- 7. Spectators should not participate in derogatory comments to referees, players, officials, or other parents. Any violator shall be immediately removed from the Event by Alaska Youth Soccer officials
- 8. Ensure that the trash is picked up after each game by the teams and their parents.
- 9. Report any problems to Alaska Youth Soccer officials.

IF THERE IS A PROBLEM CONTACT THE STATE CUP OFFICIALS AND WE WILL RESPOND APPROPRIATELY

IF THERE IS ANY VIOLENT BEHAVIOR OR ACTIONS CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY!

All participants should adhere to the AYSA State Cup Mitigation Plan and Guidelines as they will reflect the appropriate state and municipality guidelines with implanted at the venue and for the participating teams.
