

# ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

Members have access to the AYSA State Office for support and guidance throughout the year. The dedicated staff will provide real time assistance to clubs, and administrators. The AYSA office can assist clubs with writing and revising bylaws, board support, facilitate claims for injuries, provide guidance, and overall club support, along with processing AYSA club/ player/ team forms, and yearly adult volunteer backgrounds checks. Ease of having your programs, players, administrators, facilities, camps, and tournaments insured through your Alaska Youth Soccer membership fees.

Alaska Youth Soccer will be offering a yearly training for Club Administrators, Team Managers, and Coaches. In our effort to provide assistance, support, and guidance AYSA will do an informative training for your Club/ Association. This service is part of your annual Automatic Member Benefits and is at no cost to your Association.





### ALASKA CLUB TOOLKIT

Alaska Youth Soccer has transitioned many forms to a new online registration platform for players, administrators, teams, leagues, and more. The platform streamlines most of the business practices of the AYSA into an online source for Club Affiliate Forms, Adult Registration/ Background Checks, Insurance, Tournaments, AYSA Administrative and Reporting Forms, and AFL league registration/ scheduling. The "Club Toolkit" section is valuable resource for all Club Affiliate administrators, managers, and coaches.

# CLUB AFFILIATE FORMS

#### AYSA Seasonal Forms Managers:

**Team Travel Permit-** Teams traveling will apply for the "Annual Travel Permit" for all US Youth Soccer Events/ Tournaments. Valid Nov 1 - Oct 31. Submit in advance prior to team travel outside the state of Alaska.

**Guest Player Approval:** Required for Alaska registered players to receive approval by AYSA for Tournament/League participation with another team.

- In-State Permission for Alaska Players- Registered Alaska Club Player to Guest Play with a registered Alaska Club Team. Not valid for State Cup.

**Guest Player Interstate Permission:** Player from Alaska to Guest Play with a team from another State or player from another State to Guest Play on a registered Alaska Club Team.

- Out-of-State Permission for Players- Required for players to receive approval from their home state (which they reside and are registered) along with the accepting state prior to travel.

**Participant Injury:** When a participant is injured during an approved sanctioned league, practice, or tournament use the **Insurance Claim form**.

**Concussion Notification:** When a participant may have a head injury use the Possible Head Injury-Concussion Notification form. Notify AYSA within two days of incident/ accident.

Other AYSA Forms: True Age Variance, Accident-Incident Report, Club Medical Release, International Travel, Player Transfers, Member Passes, Team Uniform and State Patch Guidelines, Team Rosters, Adult Verification Policy and Procedures (managers, coaches, chaperones).


#### Affiliate Membership NEW Benefits


